Children's Program Overview

Building Bridges has 5 groups for children who attend on Thursday nights and participate in programming while their parents participate in adult classes and discussions. The children's programming includes:

- 1. Basic Child Care for infants and toddlers
- 2. Curriculum Group One is offered to children ages 4 to 6 years
- 3. Curriculum Group Two is offered to children ages 7 to 9 years
- 4. Curriculum Group Three is offered to children ages 10 to 12 years
- **5. Bridges' Teens** is discussion based, partially on items from the Adult Bridge Builder program and also character development topics.

Building Bridges' Curriculum topic modules are four sessions in length. We schedule four weeks of curriculum and use a fifth week as an activity night. Activity nights can be holiday themed, games, crafts or field trips.

Our Curriculum also includes children's books, commercial and You Tube videos, games, and activities. Module themes include character

development topics as well as skill building topics similar to those in the Bridge Builder training program.
